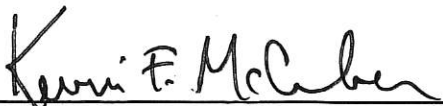

Dear Mr. Black:

On June 26, 2026, you appeared voluntarily before the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform (Committee) for the purpose of answering questions related to the Committee's investigation into: (i) the alleged mismanagement of the federal government's investigation into Mr. Jeffrey Epstein and Ms. Ghislaine Maxwell, (ii) the circumstances and subsequent investigations of Mr. Epstein's death, (iii) the operation of sex-trafficking rings and ways for the federal government to effectively combat them, (iv) ways in which Mr. Epstein and Ms. Maxwell sought to curry favor and exercise influence to protect their illegal activities, and (v) potential violations of ethics rules related to elected officials. However, during that interview, you refused to answer many questions that relate directly to the Committee's investigation. Therefore, please see the attached subpoena compelling your appearance at a deposition on July 16, 2026 at 10:00am.

The Committee has questions regarding your personal relationships with associates of Mr. Epstein and Ms. Maxwell, the use of non-disclosure and other confidentiality agreements by individuals associated with Mr. Epstein and Ms. Maxwell, efforts to exercise influence over associates to protect their illegal activities, and your knowledge of Mr. Epstein and Ms. Maxwell's illegal activities. As one of the longest known associates of Mr. Epstein, the Committee believes you possess valuable insight into his and Ms. Maxwell's activities. The Committee seeks this information to inform the development of legislative solutions to improve federal efforts to combat sex trafficking and prevent the use of non-disclosure or other confidentiality agreements to cover-up potential criminal activities.

The Committee on Oversight and Government Reform is the principal oversight committee of the U.S. House of Representatives and has broad authority to investigate "any matter" at "any time" under House Rule X.¹ Further, pursuant to House Rule XI clause 2(k)(6) "...the chair shall receive and the committee shall dispose of requests to subpoena additional witnesses."² Additionally, House Rule XI clause 2(m)(1)(B) grants Committees of the House of Representatives the authority "to require, by subpoena or otherwise, the attendance and testimony of such witnesses and the production of such books, records, correspondence, memoranda, papers, and documents as it considers necessary."³ If you have any questions

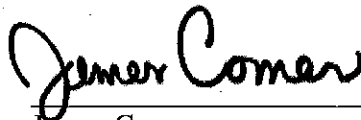
